Exhibits from the state's largest oil, cotton, & peanut producing county will be open to the public on Thursday, September 16, 2010 beginning at 8:30 a.m. These exhibits feature everything from industry equipment to financial institutions to cable television!



The Meal will be served beginning at 11:30 a.m. A Chinese Auction is held for the first bale of cotton ginned in Gaines County, and then awards for producers & industry performance are presented.

The meal is comprised of items grown within Gaines County, and costs just \$5.00 per person. If you are an exhibitor at Ag & Oil Day, your meal is free!

Donations—If you have not do-

nated previously, **we invite you to become a part of this great event.** Invoice forms are available at the Chamber of Commerce office, 119 SE Avenue B in Seminole. If you have donated in the past, your invoice is included with this brochure for the same amount you pledged last year, but please feel free to change this amount if you need to do so.

Booth Registration—A form is located on the other side of this brochure. There is no registration fee; however a donation is required. **BOOTHS MUST BE SET UP BY 6 PM ON WEDNESDAY!** To register, please print the information clearly and return it to the Chamber of Commerce no later than August 20, 2010. Each booth space is approximately 10x10 feet.

Door Prizes—Exhibitors are encouraged to have door prize drawings at their booth. If you are giving away any type of firearm, we ask that you make sure it is in the box. Here's how it works:



- 1) Each booth is responsible for registering its own drawing.
- 2) YOUR DOOR PRIZE DRAWING MUST BE COMPLETED BY 12 NOON.
- 3) Someone with the Ag & Oil Committee will come by your booth to record the **name** of your door prize winner.
- 4) Winners' names will be announced following the Chinese Auction, and

winners must return to your booth to claim their prize.

- 5) You keep the original door prize ticket so that you have all contact information in the event that a winner needs to be contacted later.



First Bale of Cotton is an exciting, competitive & profitable race, as producers in Gaines County vie for the honor each year. The cotton must be produced in Gaines County, and must be ginned in Gaines County. The producer must live in Gaines County as well. Complete rules are available at Gaines County Gins or the Chamber Office.

Another regular feature of the annual event is the Cow Patty Sweepstakes. Tickets are sold for random spaces on a grid and the winner is the one whose square corresponds with the largest amount of "patty" from the initial impact of the first cow patty. Tickets are \$5 each and the winner can receive a sweepstakes check of up to \$1,000.00!
